



Forestry Program

We have a (fully funded) partnership with Forestry SA, which students from year 5-7 participate in. We create Biodiversity Corridors which provide habitat and connect Native Forest Reserves. We collect seed and the students propagate plants in the School Nursery (approx. 3000 seedlings are produced each year). In winter we plant the seedlings into our Biodiversity Corridors. We investigate the relationships between plants and animals. All year 5-7 students go on 4 excursions per year to Native Forest Reserves. We aim to engage our students in all things environmental, thereby creating environmentally awareness and nurture a lifelong volunteering culture.
