At Newbery Park Primary School students learn art using the concepts of Bloom's Taxonomy.

Most importantly they learn how to learn and how to transfer *learning strategies* across all aspects of school and wider life experiences.

Students are taught specific art skills and how to experiment and practice them. They are encouraged to be curious and to develop their own meaningful ways of applying their ideas.

Students are taught how to think carefully about how they are going and work out what needs adjustment.

Only when students have developed a range of skills and understandings about an art medium and topic do they plan and create their own, personally meaningful product.

This method of learning enables students to reach higher levels of skill and artistic quality.
