Hats

As is usual policy, all students and staff (and parents working with students) are expected to wear sun safe regulation hats to protect against the UV rays this term. Classes and teachers for 2019

If a parent has a specific request regarding a child's placement could you put this in writing, addressed to the Principal and drop it in to the Front Office, so these requests can be taken into consideration. Due to the limited number of classroom options this is sometimes a difficult (and impossible) request to meet, however, we attempt to support where possible. We cannot look at requests for particular teachers as the classes are organised before teachers are assigned to the class. If you know that your child will not be at Newbery Park next year, or you know of any new enrolments, please let the Front Office staff know by the end of week 1.
